Trial & JC/QC Check-In & Inspection: Closes at 8:00 am with Roll Call, followed by the draw & running of the Trial

JC/QC Tests will be run BEFORE the Trial

Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period.

Early acceptance of hounds for members of the field committee may begin prior to published test or trial hours.

ELIGIBLE BREEDS AND REGISTRY-- Lure Coursing tests and trials shall be open to eligible breeds one year of age or older. For a complete listing of the breeds eligible to participate in the AKC Lure Coursing program, please visit the AKC website at: http://www.akc.org/events/lure_coursing/eligible_breeds.cfm. Eligible dogs must be either individually registered with AKC, recorded with the Foundation Stock Service (FSS), individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, or that have been granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL/ILP). Hounds that are disqualified from AKC, ASFA or CKC Field Trials may not be entered. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications.

Copies of Qualified Courser/ASFA certifications or ASFA or CKC Field Champion title certificates must be submitted to the host club when entering the AKC Open or Veteran Stake for the first time.

RIBBONS AND TROPHIES:

Green qualifying rosettes will be awarded to qualifying hounds for JC/QC Tests. Trophies will be offered for BOB and BIF
1st Place · Blue **2nd Place** · Red **3rd Place** · Yellow **4th Place** · White **5th Place** · Pink **Best of Breed** · Purple & Gold Rosette **Best in Field** · Red, White & Blue

TESTS OFFERED:

The course is a minimum of 600 yards with a minimum of four (4) turns.

JUNIOR COURSER (JC): A hound running alone shall receive one qualification from a judge, and a second qualification from a different judge at a separate event, stating that the hound completed the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

QUALIFIED COURSER (QC): A hound (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed - or another breed with a similar running style - (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. **The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course.**

STAKES OFFERED:

OPEN: Open to all hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). Championship points earned from the Open Stake will only count toward a Field Champion title. Hounds that have earned an AKC Field Championship title are not eligible to enter the Open Stake.

SPECIAL: Open to all hounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship titles.

Championship points earned from the Specials Stake will count toward Lure Courser Excellent titles.

OPEN VETERAN: Open to all hounds which are eligible to enter Open or Special stakes and meet the age requirement for a veteran as established by the breed's parent club – 6 years of age; except Irish Wolfhounds = 5 years and Whippets, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, and Afghan Hounds = 7 years. Championship points will be awarded. Points won from the Veteran Stake may count toward either a Field Championship title or Lure Courser Excellent title.

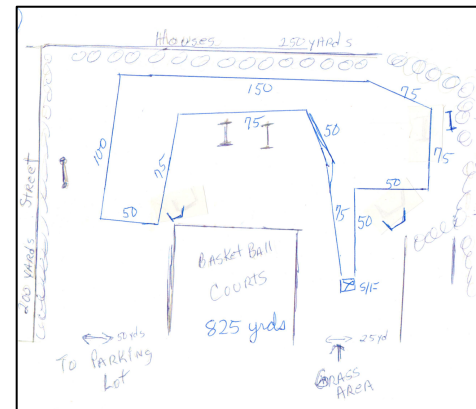
SINGLES: Open to all sighthound breeds approved to participate in AKC Lure Coursing trials. Hounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Not eligible to run for Best in Field.

Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Entry fees for hounds excused during inspection for bitches in season, lameness, or disqualifications will be refunded. Spayed and neutered hounds, without breed disqualifications, may be entered. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds that have not been neutered are ineligible to participate in the regular stakes. All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.

Equipment: Battery-powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of white or colored plastic strips. Backup equipment will be available. The members of the Bay Area Rhodesian Ridgeback Club reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the test/trial.
